COMMUNITY

- 12-month minimum commitment
- Big & Little enjoy free/lowcost activities in the community
- Volunteer must have valid driver's license and access to a reliable insured vehicle

BOTH

- Include thoughtfully matched volunteers (Bigs) with children/youth (Littles).
- Are supported by a professionally trained staff member AKA a Case Manager
- Necessitate a completed application, an interview, reference checks, and clearances
- Require a desire to build a relationship with a youth in need

SITE

- One school year minimum commitment
- Big & Little meet at a site, often a local school
- Matches are supported by an on-site BBBS staff member
- Volunteer has little interaction with his/her/their Little's parent(s)/guardian(s)

Conversations to Remember: Virtual Opp.

Details: Conversations to Remember is a nonprofit dedicated towards combating loneliness and isolation felt by senior citizens.

- 2-3 college students matched with older adults for virtual video visits ~1 hour/week for at least 16 weeks to develop meaningful relationships with the seniors.
- Mandatory training is provided to students in the program.
 - Best ways to interact with the older adults & additional regular support.
- Opportunities for additional volunteer hours are possible with other volunteering options such as assisting with social media, call support, outreach, etc.

Who We Are

Conversations to Remember is a 501(c)(3) charity whose mission is to combat feelings of isolation and loneliness among senior citizens. We facilitate weekly video calls with senior citizens, including those with dementia, with the goal of creating intergenerational friendships.

Young adult college students will engage in virtual visits with a senior citizens. These seniors are lonely, and are excited to speak with you. Each video call will have 2-3 student volunteers matched with one senior. The calls will be for one hour, at the same time each week. You will only be matched for a call at a time when you are available. You must commit to continuing in the program for at least 4 months. Conversations to Remember will provide you with training and support.



- Unique: Only school to host this type of student-run conference




