### What is THON?

- Largest student-run philanthropy in the world
- Year-long effort to raise money for pediatric cancer
- Ends in a 46 hour no-sitting, no-sleeping dance marathon
- Feb. 16-18, 2024 in the BJC!
- Each organization gets paired with a family or families who are affected by pediatric cancer
  - We are paired with the Torres family and the Shepps family

### What should I bring to THON?

#### What should I NOT do at THON?




#### **THON Dodgeball**


